

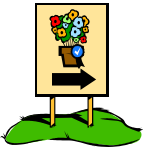

THIS AND THAT GREEN IDEAS

~ PLASTICS ~

- ◆ Do not drink water that has been left in your car overnight in the hot summer as the heat reacts with the chemicals in the plastic bottle which releases dioxin into the water. Dioxin is a toxin increasingly found in breast cancer tissue.
- ◆ No plastic containers in microwaves use Pyrex or ceramic containers for heating food.
- ◆ No plastic water bottles in freezers as this releases dioxins from the plastic.
- ◆ No plastic wrap in microwaves as the food is nuked, the high heat causes poisonous toxins to actually melt out of the plastic wrap and drip into the food.
- ◆ Cover food with a paper towel and nothing else.
